Integrated Multi-Hazard Approach: Students will acquire the ability to evaluate disaster vulnerabilities through a lens that integrates social, environmental, and economic factors, ensuring holistic and people-centred management.

COURSE COMPLETION REPORT

ADD-ON COURSE ON DISASTER ECONOMICS: FLOOD & EROSION MANAGEMENT

Organized by: Central Library

Duration: March 17, 2026 – July 10, 2026

1. Executive Summary

The Central Library successfully organized and conducted a 30 Hours Add-On Course titled "**Disaster Economics: Flood & Erosion Management**" from March 17, 2026, to July 10, 2026. The interdisciplinary course was designed to bridge the gap between economic policy and ecological disaster mitigation, specifically focusing on the socio-economic impacts of macro-level flooding and riverbank erosion. A total of 285 students/participants enrolled, with 285 successfully meeting all assessment and attendance criteria for graduation.

The Programme was initially started under the coordination of **Mr Aditya Gogoi., Assistant Professor Department of Economics**, but due some technical programme the concerned person could not able to continue the course and handed the course to **Hemanta Gogoi, Librarian** and the courses completed by the **Central Library**.

2. Course Objectives & Learning Outcomes

The core directive of this add-on program was to equip participants with both theoretical frameworks and practical analytical tools to assess climate-induced economic vulnerabilities.

- **Socio-Economic Evaluation:** Understand how to quantify direct asset losses, structural damages, and long-term indirect economic displacements caused by severe flood and erosion events.

- **Policy & Cost-Benefit Analysis (CBA):** Evaluate the financial feasibility of structural interventions (e.g., embankments, geo-bags) versus non-structural interventions (e.g., community zoning, index-based flood insurance).
- **Resource Navigation:** Leverage the Central Library's dedicated digital archives, geographic information systems (GIS) data repositories, and institutional databases for economic research.

3. Participant Performance & Metrics

Below is a summary of the participant engagement and completion analytics for the program:

- ❖ **Total Registered:** 285
- ❖ **Minimum Attendance Requirement:** 75%
- ❖ **Successful Completions:** 285

4. Library Resource Integration

As a unique initiative by the **Central Library**, this course heavily prioritized information literacy and data retrieval skills:

1. **Specialized Repository:** A dedicated physical and digital shelf on "Disaster Economics and Hydrological Studies" was curated for the students.
2. **Database Training:** Participants received specialized orientation on navigating econo-environmental databases such as EconLit, ScienceDirect, and government census data.

5. Assessment Methodology

To earn their completion certificates, participants were required to complete a multi-tiered evaluation process:

- **Continuous Internal Assessment (20%):** Weekly quizzes and module review tasks.
- **Case Study Presentation (30%):** An economic cost-benefit analysis of a real-world regional flood or erosion event.
- **Final Capstone Project / Written Examination (50%):** A comprehensive policy proposal detailing an economic framework for sustainable erosion management.

6. Major Highlights & Outcomes

Key Achievement: 100% of the graduating students successfully created an independent Economic Vulnerability Map or Cost-Benefit Model for a high-risk region as part of their final capstone project.

The feedback from participants was overwhelmingly positive; with many highlighting that the course seamlessly connected data retrieval (library sciences) with real-world financial decision-making (disaster management).

7. Recommendations for Future Iterations

Based on faculty observations and participant feedback, the following recommendations are proposed for future editions of this course:

- **Field Work Integration:** Include a 2-3 day field visit to an active flood/erosion-affected zone to observe socio-economic realities first hand.
- **Software Training:** Introduce dedicated lab hours for basic spatial economics software (like QGIS or basic R-programming for disaster modelling).
