ADMISSION POLICY (2026-27)

Introduction

Chaiduar College (Autonomous) is a provincialized college of the Government of Assam with autonomous status – the autonomous recognition was conferred by the UGC vide its letter number F.2 – 10/2023 (AC – Policy), dated 28th March 2025 which was subsequently approved and ratified by the Gauhati University vide its notification number GU/AFF/2025/9373-80, dated 25th April 2025. As per the UGC Guidelines, the degree (UG) certificates for Chaiduar College (Autonomous) will be issued by the Gauhati University (the parent university).

The admission into UG courses in Chaiduar College (Autonomous) is open to all the eligible students from India but majority of the seats, as per the guidelines and norms of the Government of Assam, are reserved for the students of the state of Assam. Even students from abroad may be admitted in different courses every year as per the guidelines of the Government of Assam and Government of India. The entire admission process of the college is supervised by the Admission Committee of the college and done through the Samarth e-Gov Suite (Samarth Portal) which has been run and managed by the Director of Higher Education (DHE), Government of Assam for facilitating admission of all the colleges in a uniform, transparent and time bound manner.

Being an autonomous college, Chaiduar College has its own admission policy without violating the broad guidelines and framework set the Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Assam, the UGC, New Delhi and the Parent University (Gauhati University). Among others, the college has the provision of admission of the ward of the existing employee of the college (sanctioned or contractual) in different stream/department/programme/course offered in the college irrespective of the marks obtained at the qualifying level of examination. If the employee quota admission cannot be granted during the merit list admission, then the same will be facilitated during the spot admission.

Reservation Policy

The college follows the reservation norms fixed by the Government of Assam.

**ADMISSION UNDER FOUR YEAR UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYUGP)
IN B. A., B. SC., B. COM. AND B. VOC. (MLT AND MM)**

All admissions will be done through the Higher Education Department's (Government of Assam) online portal: <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>

A prospective student of Chaiduar College (Autonomous) has to follow the following steps to get his/her admission done.

1. First of all, students have to check the college website/ prospectus to confirm the availability of departments, subject, honours, etc. of choice in the college.
2. After that students have to keep checking the admission timeline as given in the Samarth portal by the DHE, Government of Assam which is also uploaded in the college website.
3. Once the students complete all the formalities as per the timeline given in the Samarth Portal and the name of the students appear in the merit list of the college, students have to report in the college as per the date notified for the physical verification of the documents and payment of admission fee as fixed by the DHE, Government of Assam (applicable to APL students).
4. The admission will be done on the basis of merit, i.e., aggregate percentage obtained in H. S. (Class 10+2) in English + Best 4 Subjects or as notified and directed by the DHE, Government of Assam from time to time.
5. A student, who has passed the higher secondary/ secondary level examination (or equivalent examination as recognized and notified by the statutory bodies from time to time) in any stream from a recognized board, can apply for admission in FYUGP B. A. in any of the major subject and minor subject offered in the college under 1 Major 1 Minor category.
6. Only student from science stream at the higher secondary level/ senior secondary only (or equivalent examination as recognized and notified by the statutory bodies from time to time) can apply for major in B. Sc. , provided that the student has-
 - passed in Physics and Mathematics for B. Sc. Physics (Major)
 - passed in Chemistry and Mathematics or Physics for B. Sc. Chemistry (Major)
 - passed in Mathematics for B. Sc. Mathematics (Major)
 - passed in Biology and Chemistry for B. Sc. Botany or Zoology (Major)
7. A student, who has passed the higher secondary/ secondary level examination (or equivalent examination as recognized and notified by the statutory bodies from time to time) in any stream from a recognized board, can apply for admission in FYUGP B. Com. with major in accountancy or management or finance under discipline specific category.
8. Only student from science stream at the higher secondary level/ senior secondary only (or equivalent examination as recognized and notified by the statutory bodies from time to time) can apply for admission in FYUGP B. Voc. in Medial Laboratory Technician (MLT) under discipline specific category, provided that the student has passed in Biology.

9. A student, who has passed the higher secondary/ secondary level examination (or equivalent examination as recognized and notified by the statutory bodies from time to time) in any stream from a recognized board, can apply for admission in FYUGP B. Voc. in Mass Media under discipline specific category.
10. Students are entitled to avail the benefit of the Fee Waiver Scheme as per the norms fixed by the Government of Assam for B. A. and B. Sc. Courses only. Such students have to produce relevant income certificate/ ration card to prove the eligibility to avail the benefit of the Fee Waiver Scheme. **The benefit of the Fee Waiver Scheme of the Government of Assam can be availed only by the students of domicile of Assam.**
11. Please note that B. Com, B. Voc. (MLT and Mass Media) are self-financed courses. So student have to pay the stipulated fee (2025-26 session) as under:

If the seats remain vacant in any course(s) after the publications of the merit lists as notified in the Samarth Portal, the remaining seats will be filled up through Spot Admission – the date of which will be notified in the college website. **The spot admission will be guided by the Spot Admission Policy of the College.**

ADMISSION UNDER FOUR YEAR INTEGRATED TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMME (ITEP) IN B. A., B. Ed. and B. SC., B. Ed.

All admissions will be done through the Higher Education Department's (Government of Assam) online portal: <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>

The college offers admission in the following courses with seat capacity mentioned herewith.

A prospective student seeking admission in ITEP (B. A., B. Ed. and B. Sc., B. Ed.) in Chaiduar College (Autonomous) has to follow the following steps to get his/her admission done.

- Admission will be granted in Secondary Section of the ITEP (B. A., B. Ed. and B. Sc., B. Ed.) with 50 seats each. The admission will be based on the NCET score. The NCET examination is conducted by the NTA.
- The aggregate percentage of marks at the qualifying level (Higher or Senior Secondary Level) is 50 per cent with the applicable relaxation for the students of the reserved category.
- A student, who has passed the higher secondary/ secondary level examination (or equivalent examination as recognized and notified by the statutory bodies from time to time) in any stream from a recognized board, can apply for admission.
- The admission in a Major Course in B. A., B. Ed. is offered only in the following subjects: Assamese/Bodo/Economics/English/History/Political Science.
- The admission in a Major Course in B. Sc., B. Ed. is offered only in the following subjects: Botany/Chemistry/Mathematics/Physics/Zoology.
- Only student from science stream at the higher secondary level/ senior secondary only (or equivalent examination as recognized and notified by the statutory bodies from time to time) can apply for major in B. Sc., B. Ed. programme, provided that the student has-
 - passed in Physics and Mathematics for B. Sc. Physics (Major)
 - passed in Chemistry and Mathematics or Physics for B. Sc. Chemistry (Major)
 - passed in Mathematics for B. Sc. Mathematics (Major)
 - passed in Biology and Chemistry for B. Sc. Botany or Zoology (Major)
- Once a student appears in the NCET, he or she will have to keep checking the admission timeline as given in the Samarth portal by the DHE, Government of Assam which is also uploaded in the college website. It means that the prospective student will keep checking Chaiduar College (Autonomous) ITEP website <https://itep.chaiduarcollege.ac.in> as well as the college main website <https://chaiduarcollege.ac.in> for latest updates.

- The reservation policy of the Government of Assam is followed while admitting students in different courses in Chaiduar College (Autonomous). The present reservation formula is as follows:

UR	: 51 Percent
OBC/MOBC	: 27 Percent
SC	: 07 Percent
ST (Plains)	: 10 Percent
ST (Hills)	: 05 Percent

Please note that if seats remain vacant in any reserved category after the admission given on the basis of merit lists, the remaining seats will be transferred to UR category.

The students from outside the state of Assam or abroad will be admitted as per the guideline of the Government of Assam and the other concerned statutory bodies.

- Once the students complete all the formalities as per the timeline given in the Samarth Portal and the name of the students appear in the merit list, students have to report in the college as per the date notified for the physical verification of the documents and payment of admission fee as fixed by the DHE, Government of Assam (applicable to APL students). For students from outside the state or long distance students or students with issued in reporting for physical verification of documents may be given the option of online documents verification and counselling.
- This course is a self-financed course and, hence, students have to pay the admission fee and other fees as prescribed from time to time by the college authority. The fee details and other details of the programme are available in the Chaiduar College (Autonomous) ITEP website (<https://itep.chaiduarcollege.ac.in>).
- If the seats remain vacant in any course(s) after the publications of the merit lists as notified in the Samarth Portal, the remaining seats will be filled up through Spot Admission. **The spot admission will be guided by the Spot Admission Policy of the College.**

ADMISSION IN COLLEGE HOSTEL (BOYS AND GIRLS)

Once admission is granted in any course of the college, then the students can apply for hostel accommodation in the college. The college, at present, has around 100 seats in the girls' hostel and around 40 total seats in the boys' hostel – out of which seats will be allotted as per the vacancy in both the hostels. The hostel admission will be given in a transparent mechanism on merit basis. The distance between the college and place of residence will also be taken while allotting hostel seats in the college. The students, seeking admission in hostel, have to give their preference in the Samarth Portal at the time of filling up the admission form. The necessary formalities in the Samarth Portal should be completed in order to avail hostel seat after admission is granted in the college.

SPOT ADMISSION POLICY

The spot admission will be done on the basis of number of seats available in various courses/ departments after the completion of admission based on the merit lists. The admission under the spot admission mechanism will be given under the following heads:

For spot admission, Samarth admission forms along with all requisite documents will be collected from the students in offline or online mode (mode of form submission for spot admission will be notified separately) on the dates mentioned in the Samarth Portal/College website and then the merit list will be prepared and published in the college website. If seats remain vacant after the spot admission on 15th June 2026, the Office of the Principal will decide on admitting students on case to case basis on any of the above mentioned quotas till seats are filled up.

If students fail to submit the original documents at the time of spot admission, their applications may be rejected. However, additional time may be granted to the students on valid ground.

Areas reserved under sports, cultural and literary quota are as follows:

- Any other relevant field (to be determined by the college) where a student has achieved praiseworthy success, the college authority reserves the right to grant admission under special consideration. - Preference will be given to the students of Assam in the admission to self-financed courses (including the ITEP). Within this criterion, preference may be given to the students of neighbouring areas / fringe villages.
